The camp is just one night away. It will allow the Scouts to take part in Jamboree on the Internet and also take part in some other activities based around communications and computers.

These will range from making Morse code devices, and their own video's.

Scouts will be sleeping in tents on the campsite, which they will need to put up on arrival.

The cost of the camp is only £8 and includes a meal on Saturday night and breakfast on Sunday.

Since it is such a cheap camp, we will collect the complete fee in as oppose to a deposit with a balance due later.
