Information

The camp is a just a one night away. It will allow the Scouts to take part in Jamboree on the Internet and also experience some other forms of communications.

These will range from hand held radios, Morse code and learning how to use GPS devices.

Scouts will be sleeping in tents on the campsite, which they will need to put up on arrival.

The cost of the camp is dependant on how much the Scouts have helped in fundraising activities this year.

For those that have not helped at any, the full cost of £12 per head will have to be paid. If you have helped at either the bag pack and sponsored hike (and **returned** sponsorship money) it will be reduced to £10. For those that helped at the bag pack and **returned** sponsorship money it will only cost £7.

When returning the form, everyone just needs to pay a deposit of £7. For those that need to pay extra a letter will be sent back saying when it needs to be in by.

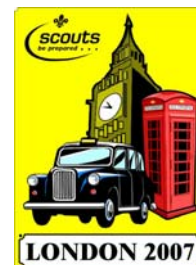
