# INFORMATION

The camp is just one night away. It will allow the Scouts to take part in Jamboree on the Internet and also take part in some other activities based around technology and gadgets.

These will range from Photography, music making, making animated videos, pod casting, electronic kits, games consoles and crafts based on technology.

JOTI involves 'talking' to other people from around the world by typing in a Scoutlink Chat room. A good competency in typing and spelling is needed to get the maximum benefit out of this.

Scouts will be sleeping in tents on the campsite, which they will need to put up on arrival.

The cost of the camp is only £12 and includes a meal on Saturday night and breakfast on Sunday.

Since it is such a cheap camp, we will collect the complete fee in as oppose to a deposit with a balance due later.

The permission form and fee must be returned no later than 30<sup>th</sup> September together with the health form if you want to go.

We can only take a maximum of 24 Scouts. **NO** late bookings will accept.

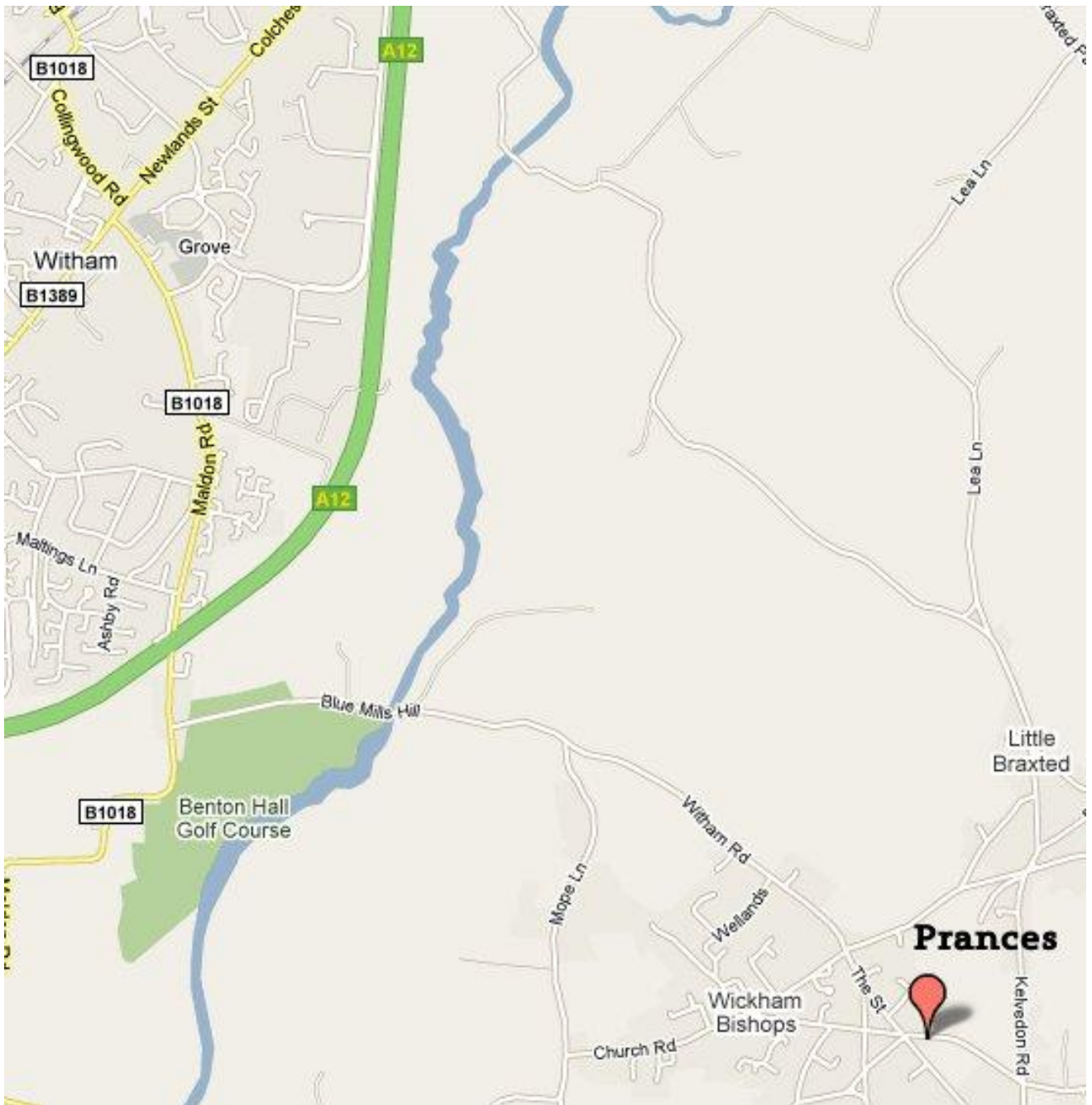

# DIRECTIONS TO PRANCES

From Silver End

Leave the A12 at the slip road (B 1389) for Witham follow road towards Witham then at the traffic lights turn left. Continue to 3rd roundabout (mini) turn left into Maldon road In half a mile pass under A12 then take second left.

You should then see Benton Hall Golf Course on your right. (There are Brown signs directing to Benton Hall G.C. from the A12.) Continue on this road for 2 miles (approx.) over narrow bridge up the hill into Wickham Bishops, keep on the same road going through the Village, then turn left between The Mitre PH. and the Garage into Great Totham Road. Entrance to Prances in 300 yards on right.
